

Part 2: Short Story Elements

Character: A person of animal in a story

Genre: A type of story like science fiction or fantasy

Foreshadowing: Clues or hints about what is going to happen in a story

Falling Action: The action immediately following the climax

Exposition/Introduction: The background information of a story **Mood:** The feeling that the author wants to reader to experience

Theme: The main message in the story

Suspense: The part of a story that build suspense

Conflict: The problem of struggle in a story

Plot: The storyline/events of a story **Climax:** The turning point in the story

Flashback: When a character thinks back to a time in the past

Setting: Where and when a story takes place

Irony: The use of words to convey a meaning that is opposite of its literal meaning **Symbol:** When something represents something else in addition to its literal meaning


Rising Action: Everything after the conflict but before the climax
